

ORDINANCE NO. 1394-08-2016

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF GAINESVILLE, TEXAS
ADDING REFINERY ROAD TO THE DESIGNATED
TRUCK ROUTE; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE;
PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF CONFLICTING
PROVISIONS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND
MAKING AN OPEN MEETING FINDING.**

WHEREAS, a new development is starting on the northeast corner of Interstate 35 and Highway 82; and

WHEREAS, a construction contract has been signed to restructure Highway 82 through Gainesville.

WHEREAS, Refinery Road has been rebuilt with concrete.

**NOWHEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF GAINESVILLE, MEETING IN REGULAR SESSION:**

Section 1. Findings.

The foregoing recitals are incorporated into this ordinance as findings of fact.

Section 2. Amend Chapter 11 – Motor Vehicles, Article III – Operation of Vehicles Generally, Section 11-152 - Designated Routes.

Chapter 11 – Motor Vehicles, Article III- Operation of Vehicles Generally, Section 11-152 – Designated Routes shall be amended to read as follows.

Sec. 11-152. - Designated routes.

For the purposes of this article, the following streets and thoroughfares within the city are designated as truck routes:

- (1) Interstate Highway 35.
- (2) United State Highway 82.
- (3) Farm to Market 51.
- (4) Farm to Market 372.
- (5) Farm to Market 678.
- (6) Farm to Market 2071.
- (7) Farm to Market 3092.
- (8) The 600, 700, 800, 900, 1000, and 1100 blocks of Scott Street (from FM 372/Grand Avenue to Railroad Avenue).

- (9) The 900, 1000, 1100, 1200, 1300, 1400, 1500, and 1600 blocks of Dixon Street (from U.S. 82 to Foreline).
- (10) 1000 East Old Sivels Bend Road.
- (11) The 3600, 3700, 3800, 3900, 4000, and 4100 of North Weaver (from FM 372 to Interstate Highway 35).
- (12) Refinery Road.

Section 3. Severability

If any provision, section, subsection, sentence, clause, or phrase of this article, or the application of same to any person or set of circumstances is for any reason held to be unconstitutional, void or invalid, the validity of the remaining portions of this article or their application to other persons or sets of circumstances shall not be affected thereby, it being the intent of the city council in adopting the ordinance from which this article derives that no portion hereof or provisions or regulation contained therein shall become inoperative or fail by reason of any unconstitutionality, voidness or invalidity of any other portion hereof, and all provisions of this article to be severable for that purpose.

Section 4. Repeal of Conflicting Ordinances

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this article are hereby repealed.

Section 5. Effective date

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage and publication in accordance with the provisions of the *Texas Government Code and City Charter*.

Section 6. Open meeting finding

It is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this ordinance is passed was open to the public as required and that public notice of the time, place, and purpose of said meeting was given as required by the Open Meetings Act, *Chapter 551 of the Texas Government Code*.


INTRODUCTION, FIRST READING, CHARTER SUSPENSION


