Mayor Goldsworthy thanked Judge Haverkamp for taking the time to administer the oaths, and further thanked the Council members for their dedicated service to the community.

**ELECTION OF MAYOR PRO TEM**

Councilman Tommy Moore was nominated and elected by Councilmembers to serve as Mayor Pro Tem for the next Council year, May 2020 to May 2021.

Councilmember Keeler nominated Tommy Moore for Mayor Pro Tem, and Councilmember Eberhart seconded the nomination. Nominations ceased and Mayor Pro Tem was elected by vote of 6 Ayes, 0 Nays, 0 Abstentions, 1 Absent (Clegg).
