BOARD OF ADJUSTMENTS

Mr. LeBaron then presented discussion as to the reasons for a fifty-foot right-of-way on this street rather than the normal forty-foot variance, which is customary for a county road. Mr. Hawkins asked for further discussion, received none. Mr. James Canaday made a motion to grant the five-foot variance to the Faith Luthern Church and was seconded by Mr. Robert Boone. Motion carried unanimously.
