

ZONING BOARD OF ADJUSTMENTS AND APPEALS

1. Considered the request of Harvey Street Baptist Church for a special exception to the side yard to make an addition to their building. Ray Phelps was present with plans for the addition. The setback according to the ordinance should be 20' and they were requesting 18' from property line. Mrs. Cordie Paclik spoke in favor of the change. Ed Hinkle made a motion, seconded by Jim Homer that the new addition be line up on Harvey Street with present building with a 7' setback and with a 18' setback from property line on Commerce Street, this being a 2' variance on East side. Motion carried by the following vote: Ayes: Bianchi, Pulte, Homer, Hinkle, Hawkins and Allen. Nays: None. Absent: James Cannaday.
