The Zoning Board of Adjustments and Appeals met on the above date with the following members present: Ed Bianchi, Chairman, James Cannaday, Ed Hinkle, Don Hawkins and Dr. Ray Allen. Absent: William Pulte and Jim Homer. Others present: Ben Armstrong, Rita Gray, Bill King and Richard Harp.

1. A request was presented by Chuck Bartush, Attorney, in behalf of Mr. Bud Manley concerning the placement of a travel home at 735 Cole Street for use during period Mr. Manley is in Gainesville. Ed Hinkle made a motion that the Board turn down the request as the property owner needs to make the request. His motion died for lack of a second. Mrs. Hazel King, owner of the property, was present and said she would make the formal request. Dr. Ray Allen then made a motion that the request for variance to the zoning ordinance be granted, seconded by James Cannaday. Motion failed by the following vote: Ayes: Cannaday and Allen.
