The Zoning Board of Adjustments and Appeal met on the above date with the following members present: Dr. Ray Allen, William R. Patterson, Ed Bianchi and James Cannaday. Alternates: Ed Hinkle and Jim Homer. Others present: Marna Ritcherson and Ben Armstrong.

The Zoning Board of Adjustments and Appeals elected Bill Patterson as Chairman and Ed Bianchi as Vice Chairman.

Mr. O. B. Coulter was present and submitted his appeal to place a house-trailer on his lot. Mr. Patterson read the correspondences between Mr. Coulter and City Manager Jimmy Dodson concerning his request.

Mrs. H. L. Hord spoke against the change concerning a drainage problem. Mr. Geo. Frost spoke against the change. A letter was read from Mrs. Edwina P. Case protesting the change.

Dr. Ray Allen made a motion, seconded by James Cannaday that special exception to the Zoning Ordinance be granted to Mr. O. B. Coulter to place a trailer house on his property for his Daughter and son-in-law only for a period of 24 months. Motion carried, unanimously.
