The **second item of business** was Discussion and Action on minutes from January 24, 2010. A motion to approve the minutes was made by Nancy Brannon with a second by Dan Ott. Ayes: Brannon, Herrmann, Lira, Ott, and Russell. Nays: None. Absent: Johnson, McKenzie.

The **third item of business** was Citizen/Tenant comments. Mr. Sullivan advised the board that airport tenants Mr. Sepko and Mr. Brown addressed the City Council at their last meeting inquiring about the feasibility of having water and sewer lines extended to their hangars. Mr. Sullivan advised the board that Director Vinton is working with the Public Services Department to acquire a cost estimate and layout plan.

Mr. Sullivan also informed the board about the planned installation of water lines that will encompass the airport. He further mentioned that this improvement to the airport will provide an ample water supply for development at the airport.

The **fourth item of business** was Discussion on the status of the Non-Directional Beacon. Director Vinton advised the board that the City Attorney, Mr. Harris, has been out of the office due to illness. Therefore, the letter to FedEx has not yet been sent. Mr. Sullivan instructed Mr. Vinton to contact Mr. Harris's business partner, Mr. Hatcher, to write the letter in Mr. Harris's absence.

The **fifth item of business** was an update on Taxiway Alpha, Delta, & Echo. Mr. Vinton advised the board that TXDOT is waiting on some financial information from the contractor and that we should be having a Pre-Construction meeting in two weeks. Mr. Russell expressed concern with the correct laying of the pavement during the project. Mr. Sullivan asked Mr. Vinton to have a representative from the city's street department on site to perform temperature readings during the paving sequence.


