Discussion included topics concerning the need to offset the hangar for vehicle traffic, current utility locations, and the distance required from the West end of the existing hangar. Director Vinton advised the board that he will work to find the optimal location for the request. A motion was made by Ms. Brannon to table the request with a second by Mr. McKenzie. Ayes: Brannon, Lira, and McKenzie. Nays: None. Absent: Herrmann, Ott, and Russell.






